Why Workplace Giving?





Workplace giving provides you with the opportunity to give in a sustainable way to Catholic Mission so that together, we can reach out and give life to those most in need in communities around the world.



Benefits of Workplace Giving

- You are in control of how much you donate from each pay.
- Your donations are pre-tax, reducing your taxable income.
- It's all organised through your payroll so there's no administration on your behalf.
- There's no need to collect receipts and wait until year-end to claim tax back.
- Regular giving makes it easier for us to plan how we can achieve more in communities with the generous support you provide.
- Connects you with the work of Catholic Mission through other programs such as staff immersions or formation, Socktober, volunteering, events and more.

You decide

- \$16**
 per pay can help provide books and study resources for children in school to help give them opportunities for a better future.
- \$35**
 per pay can help support the families of people with disability by providing access to medical care and support at home.
- \$60**
 per pay can help educate a tertiary student for a year as they journey toward completing an important milestone.

 per pay can contribute toward the cost of a water tank that provides clean drinking water for a community.
