

Your Giving in Actions



Since 2011, employees have contributed over \$190,000 to Catholic Mission through Workplace Giving and have made an incredible impact in communities around the world, including:

- In India where the dairy farm at Beatrix High School has been expanded to generate sustainable income, supporting the salaries of 18 teachers for 776 students, including 170 students with leprosy.
- In Cambodia at the St Francis Technical High School which has supported 90 students in receiving vocational training in sustainable agriculture, and another 90 students in receiving tourism training.
- In Myanmar where 584 children in rural areas have benefitted from teacher training in 16 village communities.



Since 2021, employees have contributed over \$31,800 to Catholic Mission for projects in Thailand and Timor-Leste, supporting educators and students.

- In Thailand, you have helped enable the Catholic Diocesan Centre of Om Koi to support 70 students and five staff members by purchasing 30 computers and 15 power supply systems, enabling students to conduct online learning. Four students completed a Nursing Assistant Course with practical training, and five staff members received their salaries.
- In Timor-Leste, you have helped the Maria Mazzarello Vocational School to renovate the kitchen and water tank for vocational training and repair the air conditioning in the computer room, improving the environment for students. Additionally, computers, projectors, mixers, blenders were purchased, and laptops were provided for the teachers' room. Six teachers received salaries to continue assisting students in developing their professional qualifications in hospitality and culinary arts.
